

CT DIAL-UP INSTALLATION GUIDE FOR WINDOWS XP

SUMMARY

Covers setting up dial-up Internet service with windows XP.

Terminology and Settings:

UserID- username, account name, for example: freebird (all lower case letters)

Password- to prevent unauthorized usage of your Internet. Best passwords contain both letters and numbers, the longer the better.

Avoid common or close names, such as your child's, spouse's, dog's and/or interest's or hobby names.

Example of a good password: g6q7pa96i (all lower case letters)

E-mail name- "@ctcn.net" after username. Example: freebird@ctcn.net (all lower case letters)

E-mail server names:

Incoming mail (POP,IMAP, or HTTP) server- pop.ctcn.net (all lower case letters)

Outgoing mail (SMTP) server- mail.ctcn.net (all lower case letters)

DUN- Dial-Up Networking- Software allowing you to dial-up our Internet Access Server.

Outlook Express- E-mail software that enables you to send and receive email.

IE- Internet Explorer- Software that is used to browse the web.

Desktop- The first screen Windows shows right after booting. This screen contains icons for Windows navigation and starting programs.

INSTRUCTIONS

Windows XP

1. Power on your computer.
2. Left Click the "Start" button.
3. At this Menu screen, hold your cursor over "Control Panel."
4. When menu on the left appears, Double Left Click "Network Connections."
5. At the "Network Connection" dialog box, Left Click "Create a new connection."
6. At the "Welcome to the New Connection Wizard", Left Click "Next>."
7. For "Network Connection Type", Left Click the radio button "Connect to the Internet" (usually set as default).
8. Left Click "Next>."
9. At the "Getting Ready" dialog box, Left Click the radio button "Set up my connection manually."
10. Left Click "Next>."
11. At the "Internet Connection" dialog box, Left Click the radio button "Connect using a dial-up Modem" (usually set as default).
12. Left Click "Next>."
13. At the "Connection Name" dialog box, type in the name "CTCN" without the quotation marks.

14. Left Click "Next>."

15. At the "Phone Number to Dial" dialog box, type in "6523524" without the quotation marks.

16. Left Click "Next>."

17. At the "Internet Account Information" dialog box, using lower case letters enter your username (without @ctcn.net) and password.

18. Un-check the check box "Turn on Internet Connection Firewall to this Computer" (unless your an advanced user and can configure a firewall).

19. Left Click "Next>."

20. At the "Completing the New Connection Wizard" dialog box, Check the check box "Add a shortcut to this connection to my desktop" (optional).

21. Left Click "Finish."

* You should be able to use the connection you just set up to connect to the Internet.
